Occasionally, the owner of The Crimson Moon Café climbs on stage to join them for a few songs as well, but anyone who knows how to play an instrument or sing is welcome to join in – often with talented musicians picking on their instruments to back you up if desired! **The 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday Traditional Jam is hosted by members of Graybeard; The 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday is hosted by Bluebilly Grit; the 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday is hosted by The Buzzard Mtn. Boys and/or Barefoot Creek; and the 1<sup>st</sup> & Last Sunday jams are hosted by any players who show up that are 'gig-free' for the afternoon!**
